Respiratory Surgery

Brachycephalic Airway Syndrome is a very common diagnosis amongst the French bulldog breed due to their physical composition.

Average cost including pre surgery work up is:
\$3,000 – 10,000

Chronic Conditions

Allergies and Skin Conditions:
from \$150 – 200 per month

Gastrointestinal Issues:
from \$50 per month

Ear Issues and Infections:
\$200 per occurrence

Dry Eye treatment: \$250 – 2,500*
if surgery required

Breeder Price

Puppies: \$3,000 – 15,000

Adults (over 6 months): \$1,000 – 3,000

Reproductive Health

Desexing: \$300 – 600

C-section for mother dogs:
\$600 – 2,000

Other Possible Surgeries

Intervertebral
Disc Disease (IVDD):
\$1,500 – 4,000

Cherry Eye: \$400 – 1,000
depending on severity.

Entropion: \$500 – 1,500

Chest Bone Deformity: \$200 – 5,000
